Mark's Message

Most of the time when these devotionals are written, I have NO IDEA what I am going to write about. It's usually early in the morning, I am half asleep, haven't had my breakfast or my coffee, and there I am sitting at the computer praying, "Lord, please give me a message for today". And praise God He does! Sometimes it's a very general message, and sometime I find out much later that it spoke to someone very specifically. Sometimes the message that He has laid on my heart is very clear, other times I struggle to understand. But it gets done, and it's not anything I do ... I'm just the typist.

Today is one of those days that the message is very clear. A question is laid on my heart this morning: "If this were your last day, what would you do?" In John chapter 17 verses 1-5 Jesus is about to cross the Kidron Valley to go to His death. He stops and looks toward Heaven to pray, and says to His Father "I have brought you glory on earth by completing the work You gave Me to do." These were Jesus' last moments on earth. He has been given all authority by His Father, yet He is still seeking His Father's power and will. He is still seeking to glorify the Father.

If you knew today were your last day on earth, what would you do? Would you: Spend your day in prayer thanking God and asking Him to bring you swiftly into His presence?

Spend the day with your family and friends saying goodbye? Party till you passed out?

Eat all the stuff that you know is not good for you?

Plead with God for one more day?

Hide, thinking He could not find you?

Talk to your pastor or Christian brother or sister for advice on what to do?

Run screaming into the street?

Max-out the credit cards?

Go and look at the wonders of God's creation?

Fall on your knees and beg for mercy and forgiveness?

If you knew that today was your last day, what would you do? What could you do? Could you say like Jesus that you had completed the work on earth that the Father had given you to do? Or would you fall short of His glory? Could you say like Paul that you had "fought the good fight"? I think that if it were my last day, I would spend it on my knees asking for forgiveness, praying that God would bring me swiftly into His presence, and thanking Him for amazing grace and allowing me to serve Him in the tiniest measure.

So, what's the point of all of this speculating on today being your last day? It might be.

Lord, we come into your courts this morning with praise and thanksgiving that you allow us to serve you another day. Be with us as we go into the world and give us a bold witness. Give us the strength to complete the work you have set before us, and keep us mindful that in all things we should give You the Glory. Help us to live every day as if it were our last day. We pray these things in the name of Jesus. Amen.


