

A Note From Pastor Donnie

Dear Church,

Live streaming a worship service is hard - when you don't know what you're doing; and when you are trying to learn it in a few days. Most of my learning came through trial and error. I desperately wanted to get it working by service time. I had the video portion up and running fairly quick, but the audio tried my patience and tested my persistence. Several times I just wanted to give up and tell everyone it would be one more week. Several times I held my head in my hands in exasperation. Several times I said a little prayer that God would help me (I should have prayed more). I watched, what seemed like, a thousand YouTube video's of other people hooking up their live streaming devices. They made it look easy, but there was always one element missing: they were not using a sound board. Finally, on Sunday morning with 20 minutes to spare I figured out the audio – sort of. Our worship service was Live Streamed to my Facebook page because I didn't have the password to the Church's Facebook page. Most people who watched it reported that it came through just fine, but a few said there was a problem with the audio. So, this week I'm back to "school" to figure out how to increase the quality of the audio. Hopefully, this Sunday at 9:00 am, if you are not able to make it to church, you will be able to join us on Facebook as we worship our Lord, Jesus.

Is there a moral to my story? Maybe. What do you think about the following possibilities?:

- 1. You don't know what you don't know, no matter how simple. As it turned out the fix for the audio was as simple as moving the audio cord from one jack to another. Simple right? Except for if you don't know the difference between one jack and another. Same thing if you have a spiritual question or issue. The solution may be simple, but not if you don't know it. Keep asking and seeking for answers.
- Persistence pays off. Have you ever heard the saying, "Do something even if it is wrong"?
 That does not mean that you should do something you know is wrong, just sayin'. Sometimes
 God uses the process of elimination to guide us the way He wants us to go.
- 3. When you have a problem, find someone who knows more than you. I couldn't find anyone on Saturday, but have gotten some good advice since then. Actually, I know The One who knows infinitely more than all the human wisdom in the world. He doesn't share it all with me, but I'm comforted in knowing that He lets me know what I need to know in order to live a life pleasing to Him.
