

Planting seeds in faith


There is a Small Group Bible Study every Sunday following morning worship.

# **Backpack Ministry**

We are basically starting from scratch fund wise for our Backpack ministry. We received a \$4000 grant from the Mt. Vernon Area Community Foundation that brought our funds to \$4785. I will be writing another grant in the spring through the Missouri United Methodist Foundation. I am estimating a budget of \$6500 for next year, considering cost increases and an increase in the number of students served.

To meet this budget we are going to need to do some fundraising. We have started "Cash for Backpacks".

On the first Sunday of each month, January 2nd, we are asking you to donate your loose change (checks and bills will happily be accepted). All funds will go to the Backpack Ministry. Our first two "Cash for Backpacks" collections were wildly successful with collections averaging 3.5 total backpacks each month!

This ministry is very close to my heart and I hope yours! Your support is greatly appreciated.
