Dear Church Family,

Last Sunday night the church voted by a vote of 33-2 to leave the United Methodist Church. For some of you that may be exciting, for others it may be a bit scary. Some may be glad, some may be sad.

I understand.

I have been a United Methodist pastor for 30 years. There is a lot of history there; some good, some bad, but always meaningful. The United Methodist Church has a rich history and has provided me with a ministry platform for half of my life. However, over the past several years there has been a major shift. The momentum is switched from Scriptural Holiness in the Wesleyan Tradition to a focus on making the bible palatable, and even support, for an ever-increasing immoral culture where anything goes and you get to decide what is truth.

As for me, I'm sad that the United Methodist Church has come to this, but am excited to see how God will use our church to minister within our community being free from the never-ending tug-of-war between the progressives and conservative/traditionalists.

I pray that God will instill in each of us an excitement and anticipation for an outpouring of His Holy Spirit!

A recap of where we are in the process is as follows:

-Our new church name will be Family Of Christ.

-Cowherd Law Firm (Sam) has started the process of registering our name and getting a copy of the property deed which need to be in the Conference Office by mid April.

-Sam is also working on applying for non-profit status with the IRS and securing a new tax I.D. Number for us.

-The exact amount is not determined yet, but we need to present the Conference with not more than \$39,810 to be free of past, present and future obligations, and to retain ownership of our property. We have the possibility of getting a 0% loan from a benevolent benefactor!
