Dear Church Family,

Woo hoo! It's Turkey Month! Your one time per year of mandatory thankfulness. Just kidding; hopefully you have had many days of thankfulness throughout the year.

The Scriptures are filled with examples of thankfulness. Abraham, David and others gave God thanks for material blessings, Jesus gave thanks before meals (e.g., before the feeding of the multitudes and announcing the New Covenant at the Last Supper), several gave thanks to God for healings, Daniel gave thanks to God for wisdom and power, others gave thanks for God's laws, salvation, safety, Christian fellowship, spiritual gifts, etc.
